

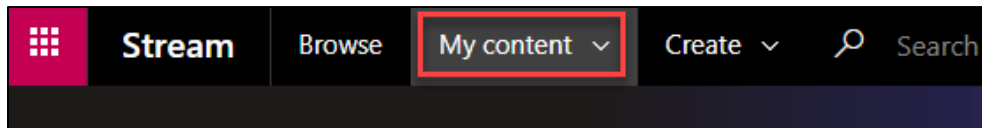

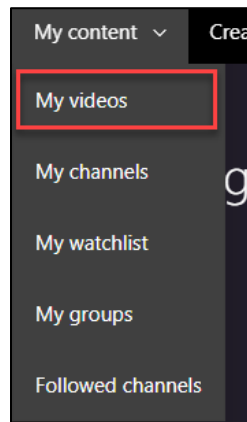
Sharing a Stream Video in Canvas

This tutorial will show you how to share a presentation in Canvas from Microsoft Stream.

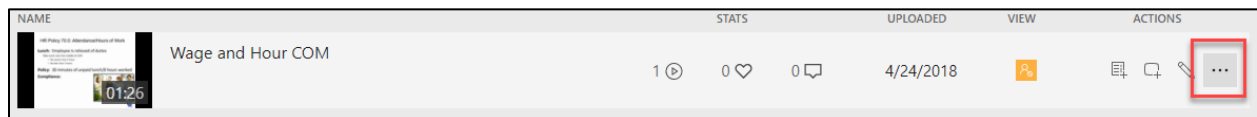
1. Select My content to access your recordings



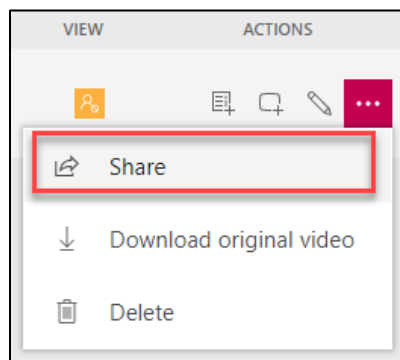
2. Select My videos



3. Select ... to show additional options



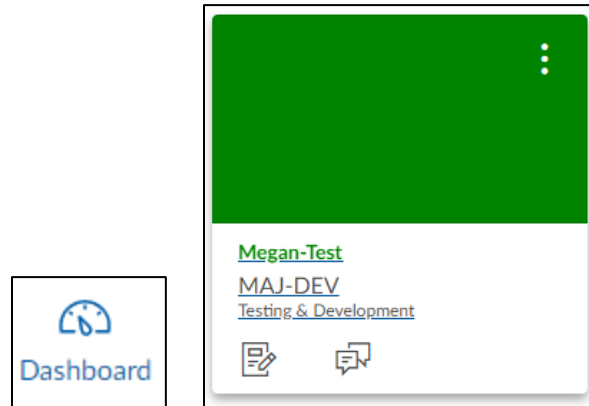
4. Select Share



5. Select Copy to copy the URL to your clipboard. This will allow you to paste it in Canvas.



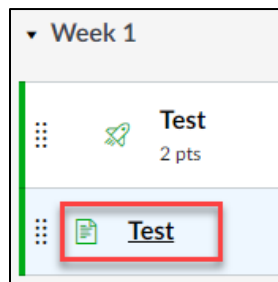
6. Visit your Canvas dashboard and choose your class



7. Select Modules to access a list of materials in your course



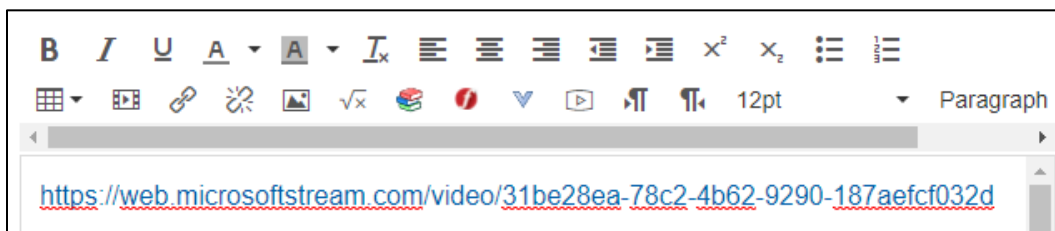
8. In this case, a Page has already been created.
9. Select the item that allows you to edit with a text editor



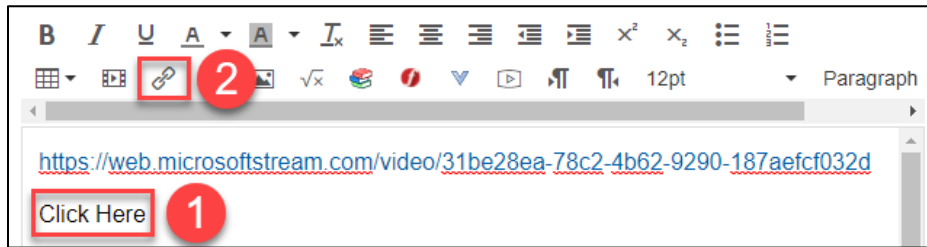
10. Select Edit to add text with the text editor



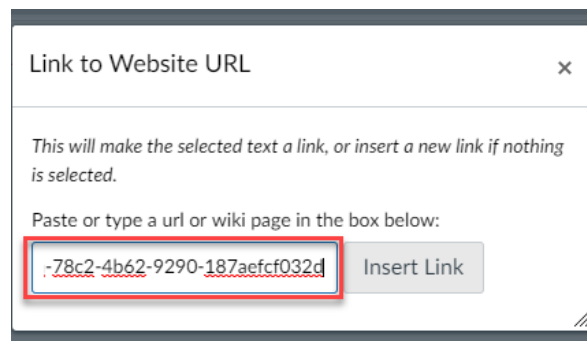
11. Select the text editor and begin adding text or paste the URL you copied from Microsoft Stream



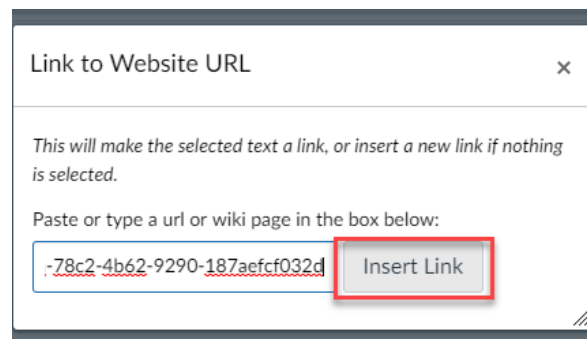
12. You can also hyperlink text to take you to the URL without showing the address
13. Highlight the text with your mouse
14. Click the Link button



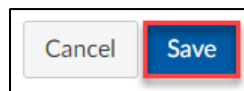
15. The Link to Website URL window appears
16. Select the text box and paste the URL you copied from Microsoft Stream



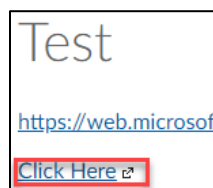
17. Select Insert Link to make the text clickable



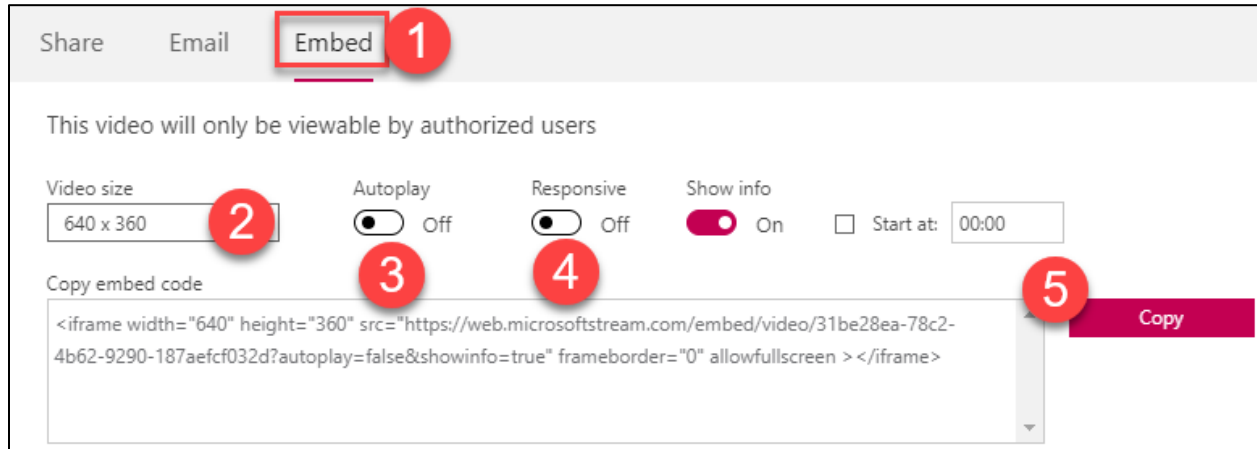
18. Click the Save button to keep your changes



19. Your text is now interactive! Try clicking on the link to visit the presentation



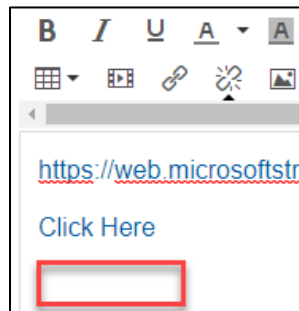
20. Your presentation should appear in a new tab. Students will be able to see this video, as long as the permissions are set correctly.
21. Select the Embed option to find the code to put the presentation directly in Canvas
22. There are a number of options to select, including Responsive, Autoplay, and Video Size. We recommend Autoplay stay Off.
23. Select the Copy button to keep the code so you can paste it in Canvas later



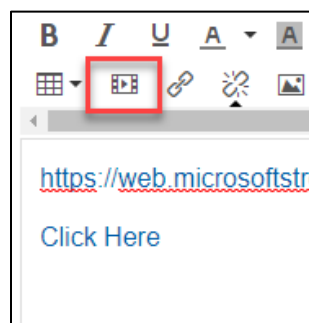
24. Back in Canvas, select the Edit button



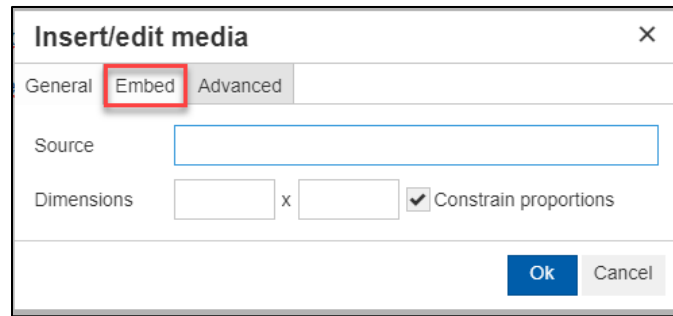
25. Select the location to place the embedded video



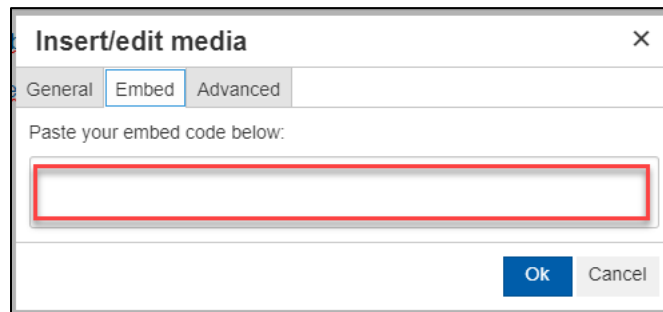
26. Select Insert/edit media



27. Select the Embed option

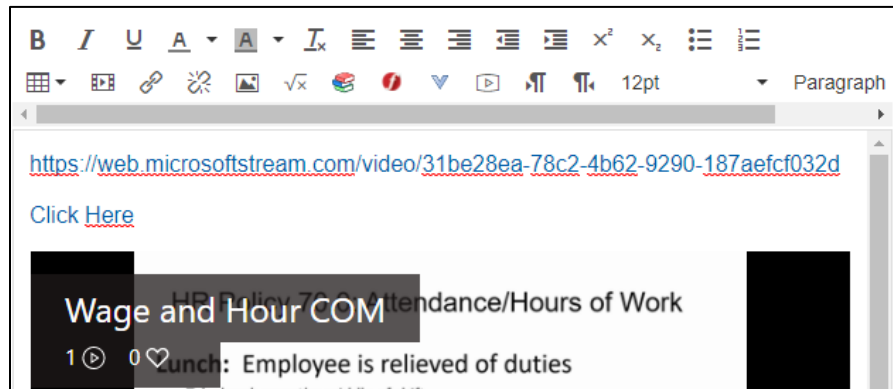


28. Select the text box and paste the code you copied from Microsoft Stream

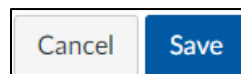


29. Select Ok to embed the presentation

30. You should see the video appear in the text editor



31. Select Save to keep changes



32. Students can now play the video from the Canvas course
